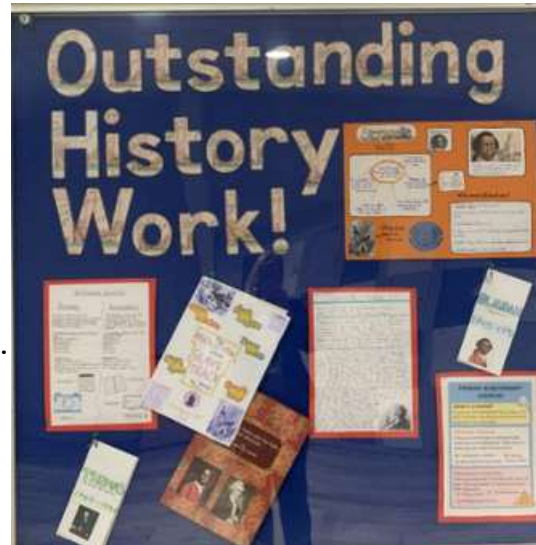

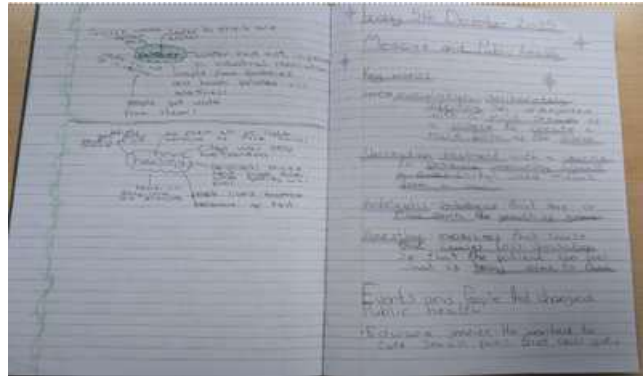

### DEVON LODGE CHRISTMAS CHOIR PERFORMANCE, Mr Kendall.

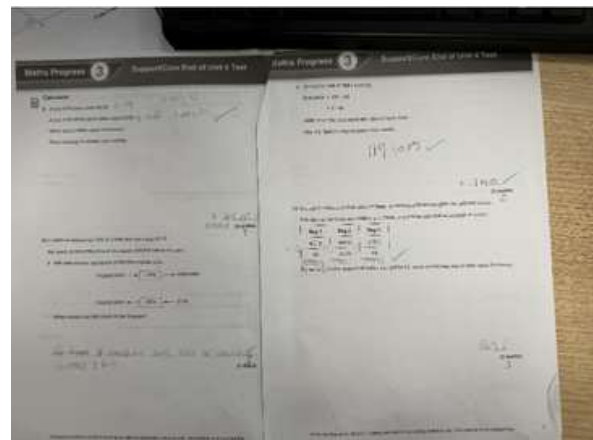
I'd like to express my great pride and gratitude to the following students for entertaining the residents of Devon Lodge Care Home on Wednesday 10th December.

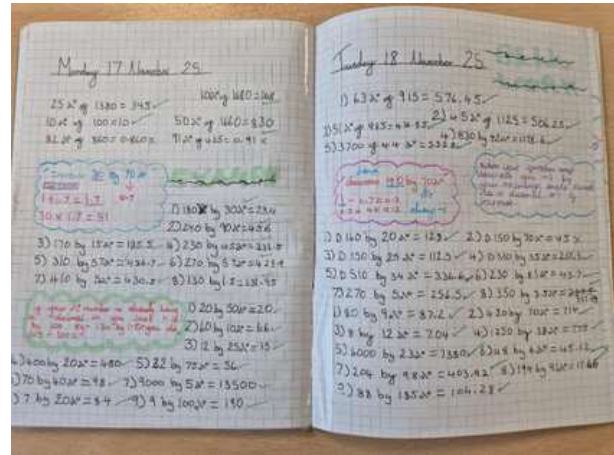
